Dear Parents and Guardians:

Last week was a friendly reminder from above that colder weather is indeed closing in on us. As much as we would love for the fall mornings and crisp evenings to stick around, winter and the weather that comes with it are on their way. This would be a great time to communicate a **CHANGE IN WINTER WEATHER CLOSINGS** for this year.

Omaha Public Schools (OPS) has the following two options for winter weather this year:

- **No School** If you see Omaha Catholic Schools make a call for "No School," this means that all classes, after school activities, and sport practices are cancelled for the day. The St. Cecilia Cathedral Child Care will also be closed for the day.
- **2-Hour Late Start** This is a new policy that OPS is implementing this year. If you see Omaha Catholic Schools make a call for "2-Hour Late Start," this means that all classes at St. Cecilia Cathedral Grade School will begin at 10 AM. You would be able to drop off your child(ren) starting at 9:45 AM. A 2-hour late start means that the Child Care Center would also be opening at 10:00 AM.

The Omaha Catholic Schools Office *usually* follows the decision of OPS, but sometimes this may not be the case. When we are expecting winter weather, be sure to watch WOWT, KETV-7, KMTV-3, KPTM FOX, and Omaha World Herald's website for "Omaha Catholic Schools - No School; Omaha Catholic Schools - 2-Hour Late Start." Another way to stay up-to-date is to follow us on <u>Facebook</u> or <u>Twitter</u>.

This new 2-hour late start will have some bugs that we'll have to work out as we go. We will still be ordering lunch from Westside but we have been told that it may affect the lunch times a bit. As soon as we experience and go through the process, I'll communicate how lunch times will work on those late start days. It's important to communicate that as your child's parent(s), on the days of inclement weather, you can also make the decision to keep your family home if you feel as though it is the safest option for you.
